

NOVEMBER 12th 2015 MEETING NOTES

DE ISC2 CHAPTER MEETING

1012hrs—Introductions around the room were conducted.

1020hrs—Meeting notes were read to the chapter, and they were then approved.

1026hrs—Mac gave a financial update to the chapter. Our current finances are at \$505.09, and a request for chapter members to pay dues for this coming year was requested and approved.

1027hrs—Inigo discussed the details of how the chapter would determine guest speakers at chapter meetings. We will be creating a formal process that will provide candidates to submit their presentations 60 days in advance, so that an appropriate agenda can be properly formed for each chapter meeting.

1030hrs—We have secured a location in Dover for our February chapter meeting. We are still committed to having a chapter meeting at least once in Dover annually.

1031hrs—The Governor's council was brought up regarding Executive Order #55. We talked about what might make sense from a chapter perspective to support this initiative. Jeff agreed to reach out to Steve Shephard from the FBI to research next steps, and possibly have a joint meeting with the Delaware Infragard Chapter on this topic.

1034hrs—The September Cyber Workshop in Dover, Delaware was a success with over 300 people present. Mac was there on behalf of our chapter and manned a table to promote the ISC2 Delaware chapter.

1039hrs—Discussion on web presence by Inigo was initiated, and a motion was passed which states that Ron Texiera will be in charge of a committee for Internet presence activities. An amendment was made to the motion which allows this committee to absorb all prior work the chapter has done to this date. This was approved by the chapter.

1045hrs—Chapter Dues were discussed and the importance of ensuring working capital for our chapter activities moving forward. Notice to all chapter members will go out in November requesting dues be paid by December 31st 2015.

1048hrs—Jeff presented an introduction to ‘Mentoring and the Security Professional’. This is an area in which we as a chapter will explore how our members can help those looking to break into this career field.

1105hrs—Fernando provided a wireless password cracking demonstration using ‘Aircrack’.
